寶藏巖國際藝術村 International artist village

Treasure Hill Art Village

新注入的創作家與舊的村落之結合，讓國際藝術村—寶藏巖，成為一個獨特的藝術空間。與寶藏巖的精神相呼應，新舊共存，讓設計更添趣點。此作品概念是在寶藏巖的高點創造一個視覺點，融入村落並且成為景觀的一部分。設計源於古時候元宵節提的燈籠，不僅能從遠處欣賞，參觀者更能進入燈籠的裡面，自由穿梭。以傳統燈籠的結構材料—竹子，及新的雷射切割技術將壓克力穿孔，將細竹一根根的串起來形成一個竹棚，再將一個個竹棚連接成主體。結合輕形結構的設計、材料及功能，創造有趣的休憩空間，開放給遊客、藝術家及村民共同使用。晚上會由竹棚中心部位打光，利用細竹製造柔和的燈光，令原本開闊的屋頂變得細緻。

Treasure Hill in Taipei is an old settlement with a vision of an artist compound. The contrast between the new and the old, villagers and the artists, creates an interesting dialogue, which can be experienced by the visitors. To echo Treasure Hill's spirit, we believe it is important to inherit the old to innovate the new. Situated at the highest point of Treasure Hill, the Lightscape Pavilion becomes a focal point that can be seen from far away. The design concept is inspired by the traditional Chinese lantern, which is made with bamboo and paper. This pavilion is a lightweight structure, accompanied with curved resting benches and lighting. In the evening, the lights gently pass through thin bamboo dowels and create a soft, delicate atmosphere.
