Traditional ways are thrown away. A green space is preserved in the forecourt. Although our indoor space reduction occurred due to this, we get sunshine, fresh air, and greenish scenery which can cover larger area because of the reduction of building footprint. Memories of Old Times Each house hidden in old blocks has its own story of its own times. From every subtle context, it is like we can peek the lifestyles of that time. The mottled beams and walls are painted white without modifications on purpose. With customized iron structures and southern pine with white paint also can record times easily. Old iron windows and iron railings are preserved for correspondence from inside to outside. We use the iron bookshelves which are penetrating medium to replace closed partitions to deal with the interface of space. Roof built with tiles and solid wood beam structure can manifest the uniqueness the most. However, its old narrow and long spatial pattern causes the difficulty for sunshine to come in. Therefore, the skylight is added not only to preserve the memories of that time, but also let sunshine in and bring different views of this space. Natural light will come in and penetrate the hollow floor of the second floor. The concept of the style are Chinese-style carved windows and the word meaning of "weaving dreams" which can make the shadows of carved windows to extend, also the spaciousness it creates can also be extended. The patterns can be projected down to the space in the first floor to form the open space and make the interactions between people can be coagulated in public spaces. Blank-leaving We need to choose between function and comfort while setting the space arrangement. When we step on the stairs built by iron thin sheets which is used to connect the floors to the space for working on the second floor, we will find out that method with transparency, like reinforcement bookshelves and glass are used to prevent the situation that our sights will be blocked due to refurbishment. Correspondence between upstairs and downstairs can be connected and present the feeling from the crisscrossing between virtuality and reality. We can also jump out of the concept of closed and strict meeting room with moderate blank-leaving to make the feeling of transparency more obvious, and the atmosphere of the whole space can be changed into the bright and fresh one.
